Partial Regularity Results for Non-Linear Elliptic Systems

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1. Introduction. We shall be concerned with solutions $z = (z^1, \dots, z^N)$, in which each z^i belongs to the Sobolev space $H_k^{m_i}(G)$ for some $m_i \geq 1$, of the equations

(1.1)
$$\int_{G} \sum_{i=1}^{N} \sum_{|\alpha| \leq mi} \zeta_{\alpha}^{i} A_{i}^{\alpha}(x, Dz) dx = 0 \quad \text{for all} \quad \zeta \in C_{c}^{\infty}(G).$$

Here $x=(x^1, \dots, x^r)$, $\alpha=(\alpha_1, \dots, \alpha_r)$ is a multi-index (each α_i is an integer ≥ 0), $|\alpha|=\alpha_1+\dots+\alpha_r$, each m_i is an integer ≥ 1 , Dz stands for $\{z_{i,\alpha}^i\}$ where $z_{i,\alpha}^i$ means $D^{\alpha}z^i$ for $0\leq |\alpha|\leq m_i$, and k is a real number ≥ 2 . The notations used will be those of the author's recent book [2] (see pages 4, 5) for the most part.

We shall first consider the cases where the A_i^{α} are of class C_{μ}^2 for all (x, p) and satisfy the following conditions:

$$|A(x, p)|, |A_x(x, p)| \le MV^{k-1}, \qquad |A_p|, |A_{px}|, |A_{pp}| \le MV^{k-2},$$

$$\sum_{i,i=1}^{N} \sum_{|\alpha|=m_i} \sum_{|\beta|=m_i} A_{ip\beta^i}^{\alpha}(x,p) \pi_{\alpha}^{i} \pi_{\beta}^{i} \geq m^* V^{k-2} |\pi|^2, \qquad m^* > 0,$$

$$V^2 = 1 + \sum_{i} \sum_{|\alpha| \leq m_i} (z_{,\alpha}^{i})^2, \qquad k \geq 2, \qquad (p = \{p_{\alpha}^{i}\}, 0 \leq |\alpha| \leq m_i),$$

where

(1.3)
$$|A_p|^2 \text{ means } \sum_{i,j=1}^N \sum_{|\alpha| \le m_i} \sum_{|\beta| \le m_i} (A_{\alpha p \beta^i}^i)^2, \text{ etc.}, \quad m^* > 0.$$

We also consider the solutions of equations (1.1) in the case where all the $m_i = 1$, in which case we write the equations in the form

$$(1.4) \qquad \int_{\sigma} \left[\zeta_{\alpha}^{i} A^{\alpha}(x, z, \nabla z) + \zeta^{i} B_{i}(x, z, \nabla z) \right] dx = 0 \qquad \text{for all} \quad \zeta \in C_{\sigma}^{\infty}(G),$$

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
