## Quantities Related to Strictly Singular Operators

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1. Introduction. In a sense, this paper is a sequel to [1], where we studied seminorms which measured the "non-compactness" of operators. If we had followed the terminology used there, we would have called the present paper "Measures of non-strict-singularity." We introduce four "measures" as follows: For an operator  $A \in B(X, Y)$  we set

$$\Gamma(A) = \underset{M}{\operatorname{glb}} ||A|_{M}||,$$

$$\Delta(A) = \underset{M}{\operatorname{lub}} \underset{N \subset M}{\operatorname{glb}} ||A|_{N}||,$$

$$\tau(A) = \underset{M}{\operatorname{lub}} \underset{x \in M}{\operatorname{glb}} ||Ax||,$$

$$\nu(A) = \underset{codim}{\operatorname{lub}} \underset{M < \infty}{\operatorname{glb}} \underset{x \in M}{\operatorname{glb}} ||Ax||,$$

where M, N represent infinite dimensional subspaces of X and  $A|_M$  denotes the restriction of A to M. We prove the following relationships among these quantities:
