

A CORRECTION TO
ON THE PRESERVATION OF CLASSES OF FUNCTIONS

A. ZYGMUND

In the paper "On the preservation of classes of functions" by A. ZYGMUND, this *Journal* 8 (1959), pp. 889–896, an unfortunate slip in *notation* distorts Theorem 2 and Remark (ii) on p. 895. In these statements expressions of the form (λ, Λ) should be replaced by the corresponding expressions of the form (Λ, λ) .

Types (λ, Λ) —"deteriorating" classes—are of little interest. They were not intentionally introduced, though the argument of the paper shows that each (λ, Λ) is identical with the corresponding (λ, λ) , and so the problem of classes (λ, Λ) is implicitly solved.
